

## Facilities

The Shire of Irwin has several facilities for the Caravan and Camping traveller free of charge or a minimum cost including;

**Waste Dump Point** at the Town Oval on Waldeck Street, Dongara.

**Fresh Water** is available at our free water tap located near the intersection of George Street and Point Leander Drive near the playground.

**Public Toilets** are provided in Dongara, Port Denison, Knobby Head, Cliff Head and Big Freshwater Point.

**Long Vehicle Parking** is available at the Town Oval on Waldeck Street, this is a short walk to the Visitors Centre and main street Moreton Terrace in Dongara

**Rubbish Bins** are provided throughout the Shire; please leave no trace and take only memories.

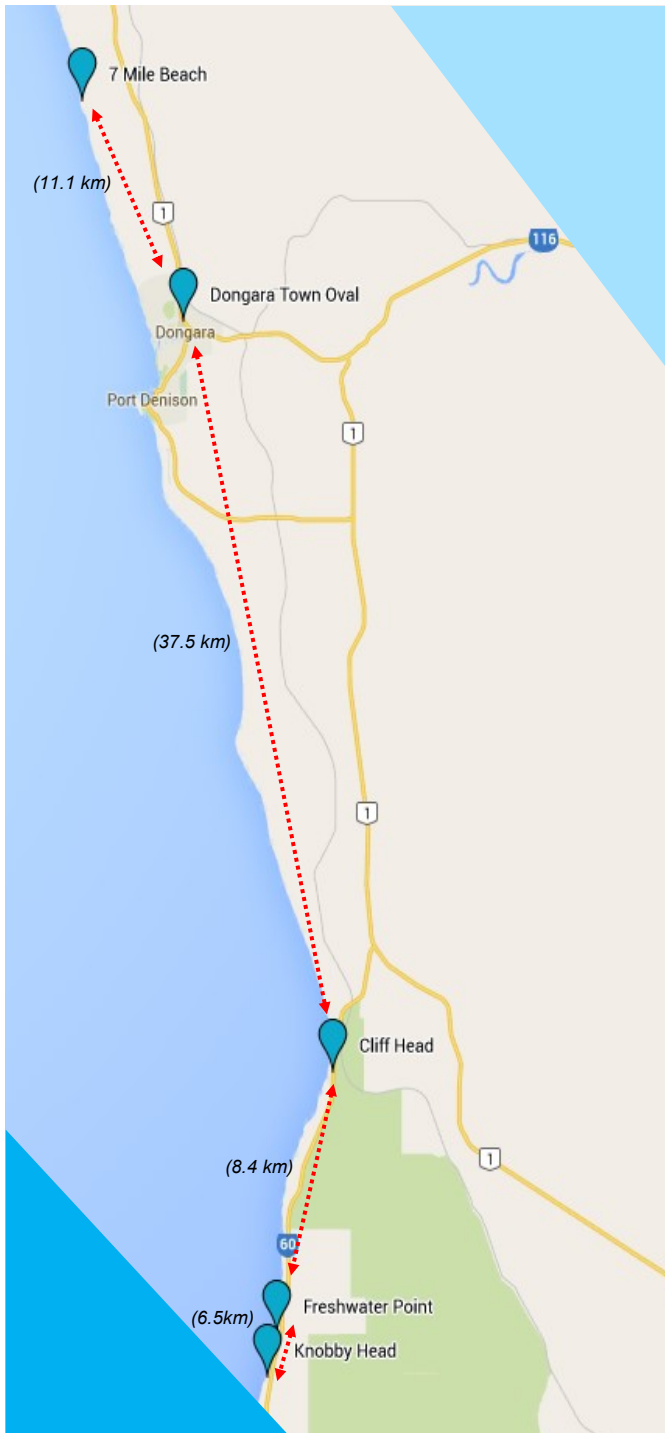

# Welcome to our twin towns Dongara-Port Denison

## About Us

We are located within the Shire of Irwin in Western Australia, approximately 360km north of Perth.

Please take the time to read this information which clearly outlines where you can camp and what facilities are provided for the travelling folk.

## Definitions

To camp when used as a verb, includes to camp in a vehicle.

Road side rest area means an area designated by a traffic sign in direct accordance with a written law, as an area which may be used for 24 hours for

- A) Resting
- B) Stopping; or
- C) Camping in a vehicle

## A Self Contained Vehicle

must carry a minimum of 20 litres of fresh water, have waste (grey) water holding tank capacity, have a portable cassette toilet, all waste must be retained within the confines of the vehicle and nothing released to the ground.

## Pets

Dogs must be kept on a leash or in control at all times, during the night they are to be locked inside the camping equipment. Dog waste bags are provided throughout the Shire.

## Camp Fires

Camp fires are highly prohibited at the Town Oval and during the total fire banned months of October to April at all other locations.

## Free Campsite information

<b>Site 1</b> (Cliff Head, Fresh Water Point & Knobby Head)	Any style of camper is allowed to stay in Site 1 for a maximum of 72 hours, after the 72 hour period is up you have to move on to another camp site, you are allowed to move to the other two sites listed within our Shire. At Cliff Head, toilets and seating are available to use.
<b>Site 2</b> (Dongara Town Oval)	Campsite 2 is for travellers with self contained vehicles only. Campers are allowed 24 hours at this campsite. A Waste Dump Point is located at this site.
<b>Site 3</b> (7 Mile Beach)	Site 3 is the last available free campsite within the Shire of Irwin. Site 3 is for travellers with self contained vehicles only. You are allowed to stay up to 72 hours. Unfortunately there are no facilities available at this campsite.

You may stay at each location once within a 28 day period. Campers may return to the camp sites in our Shire after the 28 day period ends. No fees apply, however we encourage visitors to support local businesses located in Dongara-Port Denison.

## Overnight Rest Area

Located within the Dongara town centre at the Town Oval on Waldeck Street for self contained vehicles only. This site has a Waste Dump Point. Mobile power generators external to the vehicle should only be used up to two hours and not operating after 10pm. Externally strung washing lines are not permitted.

## Overflow Camping

Located at the Town Oval in Dongara. Camping is provided at a cost of \$30 per family or \$15 per person for all campers, to accommodate the excess influx of visitors during peak tourist periods when existing accommodation providers are operating at full capacity, such as the Easter long weekend. Self-contained travellers get 1 night for free during overflow period if parked at the overnight rest area. The fee is paid to the Ranger each night by all users of the overflow campsite.
